Summary		
Project:	Revision of RSPM 35 Arthropod pest tables for stone, pome fruit trees (SPFT), and grapevines.	
General comments:	<p>Following welcoming remarks, the NAPPO TD:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Informed the EG that a document will be drafted at the end of the arthropod pest tables revision documenting the key points used to harmonize the arthropod pest status in all three NAPPO countries. This document will serve as a reference for future pest status harmonization work for RSPM 35.- Thanked the EG members that have submitted the information requested to update the arthropod pest table of grapevines and reminded those that have not sent that information to send it to him as soon as possible.- Indicated that the updated versions of the arthropod pest tables for RSPM 35 (SPFT and grapevines) will be shared with the EG once all the information is received.- Indicated that references for the category Ab3 (Absent: Pest records invalid) should be included in the SPFT table.- Informed that EG members will be contacted via email in case there is additional information required to complete the pest tables.	

	Permission was requested and granted by the EG to record the video conference for report purposes. The TD agreed to write the video conference report.	
Item 1:	Revision of SPFT arthropod pest table.	
Consensus:	Pest status for all arthropod pest species with different statuses among all three NAPPO countries was reviewed. The procedure was like that used for the grapevine arthropod pest table. Notes were taken by the chairperson and a file with all the decisions, notes, and tasks was generated and shared with the NAPPO TD.
