Revision of NAPPO's Regional Standard for Phytosanitary Measure 38 (RSPM 38) (<i>Importation of certain wooden and bamboo commodities into a NAPPO member country</i>)		
The ED welcomed and thanked members for joining the call. She reminded the EG about the documents that were sent for this call including a copy of RSPM 38, comments provided by all three NAPPO countries, and the agenda.

Item 2:	 Include additional definitions specific for this standard. A request was made for members to provide terms to include for discussions. The information was provided by EG members as requested and translated by the NAPPO Secretariat to share with all EG members. This information will be discussed during this call. RSPM 38 revision 		
Consensus:			
	The Chairperson read the comments provided by EG members including proposed terms to consider for inclusion in the definition section of the standard. EG members inquired about the availability of interception data. US and Canada informed that they have requested the information and will share with the EG. Mexico has provided interception data to the NAPPO forestry EG and will be requested from the Forestry EG to share with the revision of RSPM 38 EG. The US indicated that the data that was shared with the Forestry EG was primarily on wood packaging material. Canada's data to provide to this EG will focus on the interception of pests in the products listed in RSPM 38. Mexico's interception data includes all pest interceptions.		
	 The following points relevant to the revision of RSPM 38 were discussed: Prescence or absence of bark in bamboo products. Regulations related to specific products not listed in the standard. A table with a list of these products was suggested which will include the regulations required. Expansion of the scope based on the large list of bamboo products especially handicraft products, seeds, and others. Interception data could be useful to determine how to modify the scope. A more comprehensive list of products to consider for the standard. Consider adding more experts to the EG to address more specific issues including expanding the scope of RSPM 38. Need to regulate the product and not whether it is use inside or outside. Consider removing all aspects related to "intended use" in the standard. 		
	commodities) of RSPM 38 were addressed. Considerations were made to expand the scope of the standard. The EG agreed to remove section 1.2 and the reference for intended use in section 1.1 and 1.3 of the standard.
