Item 4:		Discuss question about Canada's OPR  Background: Canada EG member (BG) had a question for the EG and Secretariat: When posting an Official Pest Report, can the report from Canada be in English as well as in French? In earlier OPRs (around 2003 to 2007), Canada had posted OPRs in both languages under the English template (e.g. <a href="https://www.pestalerts.org/official-pest-report/update-emerald-ash-borer-agrilus-planipennis-fairmaire-ontario-canada-le-point">https://www.pestalerts.org/official-pest-report/update-emerald-ash-borer-agrilus-planipennis-fairmaire-ontario-canada-le-point</a> ). Having Canada's OPRs available in French is important for the Francophone speakers in Canada.  • In general, the group did not see an issue with having Canada include the OPR in both languages under the English template. The approach proposed is a simple solution to have Canada's OPR in English and French.  • NAPPO's ED will inform on this at the next meeting with the Executive Committee, as well as present the option of expanding the NAPPO PAS capabilities to include French as a third language.
