April is the invasive plant species awareness month for the US.</li> <li>Greg Rosenthal indicated that the event will be promoted in social media and encouraged EG to coordinate this activity to show regional solidarity and support to the IYPH.</li> <li>Canada: <ul> <li>Canada indicated that approval has been received to illuminate the Canadian Museum of Nature. Other possibilities are being explored including the Parliament building in Ottawa and the Niagara Falls.
