The phytosanitary treatments regulations contained in 7 CFR part 305 set out general requirements for conducting treatments indicated in the Plant Protection and Quarantine (PPQ) Treatment Manual for fruits, vegetables, and articles to prevent the introduction or dissemination of plant pests or noxious weeds into or through the United States. Recognition of new treatments to be added to the Treatment Manual is done through rule making in the Federal Register. New treatments are approved based on analysis and review of submitted treatment protocols and treatment data to the Treatment Quality Assurance Unit of the PPQ Center for Plant Health Science and Technology. The analysis and review of submitted treatment data is based on the best available science.
