Consensus:	<ul> <li>Canada</li> <li>System was launched for Certificate of Free Sale and dairy certificates in June.</li> <li>Working on the plant certificate system.</li> <li>Started training program for system's users.</li> <li>Planning for a system with plants in the near future.</li> <li>Will likely be able to send but not receive upon first launch.</li> <li>US</li> <li>Transitioning to new contractor for system development.</li> <li>Actively exchanging with Argentina, Netherlands, Chile and New Zealand via their own systems and the hub.</li> <li>Exchanging with Ghana, Samoa and Jamaica using the generic system.</li> <li>Working with 16 countries in the Caribbean and 30 countries in the Pacific on the generic system.</li> <li>Hosting, with the IPPC, a two-day workshop for Africa.
