# Objectives

- Design and deliver a hemispheric workshop to facilitate implementation of ISPM 38: International Movement of Seeds
- Develop the workshop for a wide range of stakeholders:
  - NAPPO member country phytosanitary regulatory officials

# Background

- After about eight years in development, ISPM 38: International Movement of Seeds adopted in March 2017
- Key features:
  - Definitions of seed-borne, seed transmitted
  - Emphasis on PRA to seed as a pathway
  - Recognizes risk reduction potential of production practices
  - Supports the use of systems approaches to reduce risk of international seed movement

# Need

- Seed trade expanding globally and in volume
  - Re-export the norm
- Countries lack PRA/risk management resources (or lack specific expertise in seeds)
  - Seed production BMPs / QMS
- International desire to create global, multilaterally accepted and implemented seed systems approach
  - ISPM 38 Annex
