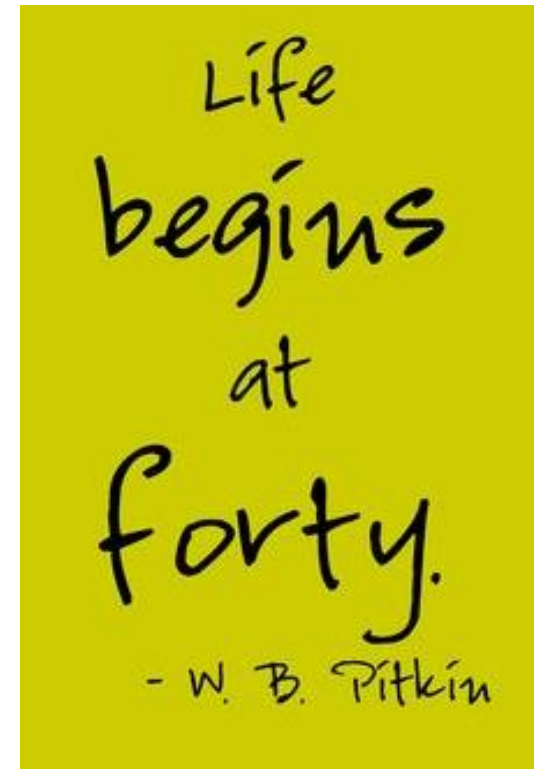

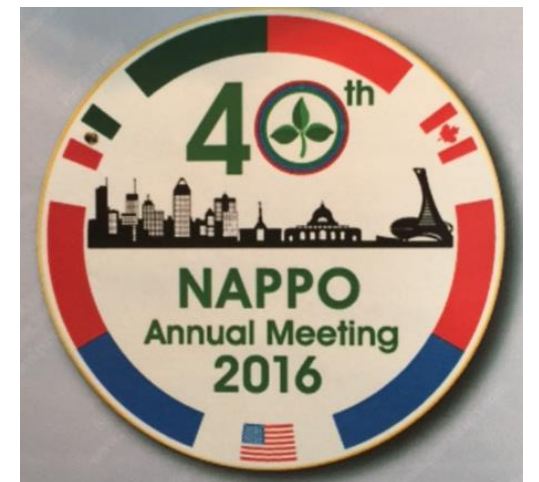

- *Cooperate* with key partners

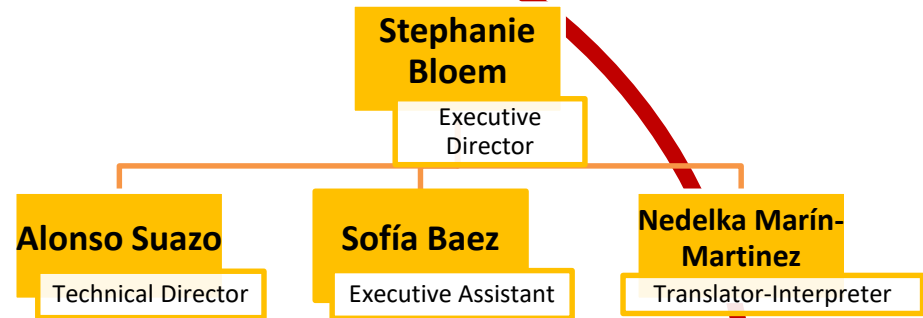

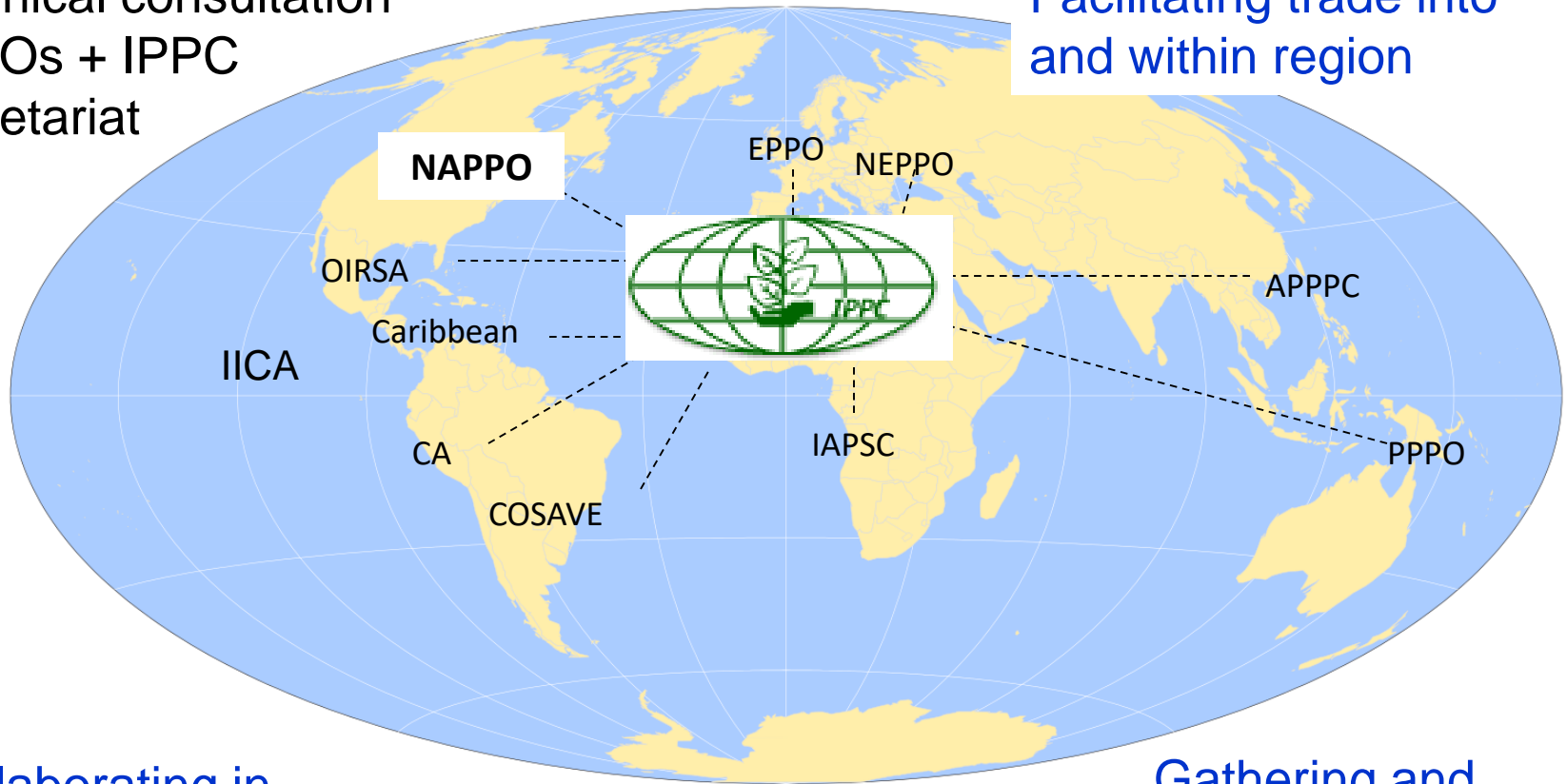

 - Secretariat resources

Revise RSPM 3 Annex 6, *Pre-shipment testing for PVYN*

Review RSPM 3 to align it with ISPM 33, *Pest free potato (Solanum sp.) micro-propagative material and mini-tubers for international trade*
