Project:	A North American Approach to Preventing Introduction, Establishment and Spread of Khapra Beetle	
Item 1:	Document to be presented at the NAPPO Annual Meeting	
Consensus:	<p>The NAPPO Secretariat presented the proposal to prepare the Khapra beetle document and have it completed for the annual meeting. Thanks to all members who provided feedback to the template. It was suggested to provide an additional week (up to the end of September) for members to keep providing feedback. The reason for this deadline is to provide enough time for the NAPPO Secretariat to compile and translate the document and send it to the EG members for review, and have a version available for October 14, 2016.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hector confirmed that Mexico continues adding information to the template and the information has been updated and it will be added afterwards to the template. • Wendy Asbil and Christina Pauk also confirmed that Canada has not finished its contributions to the document. • Scott Myers indicated that references and additional documents need to be added from all countries. • Hector Vega agreed with the previous comments and therefore, it was convened that a <u>deadline of September 30 to complete feedbacks was not realistic</u>. • The group unanimously agreed that a two week period to provide information to the template was more realistic. After this date, the NAPPO Secretariat will compile and translate the document. The result will be a document that
