Summary		
Project 1:	Finalize the document on recommended measures for the establishment and maintenance of area wide management programs for Huanglongbing and its vector.	
Consensus:	<p>Three areas of work were already determined (Propagative material production units; Area wide management and Phytosanitary measures) and each area has its coordinators. The coordinators have contacted subject matter experts that will help in the development of the document.</p> <p>Coordinators will confirm subject matter experts and present 1st draft by March 13, 2014.</p> <p>Ana Lilia proposed the addition of Adriana Miranda as an expert from Mexico to collaborate in the preparation of the chapter “Phytosanitary measures.”</p>	
Project 2:	Identify new and emerging citrus quarantine pests and methods for their identification and management	
Consensus:	<p>The objective is to collect information on emerging citrus quarantine pests. A template will be agreed upon. Focus for now will be on leprosis, sweet orange scab, citrus black spot, citrus variegated chlorosis, and canker.</p> <p>Christina Devorshak will check on whether APHIS might have examples of similar documents (eg. broadened fact sheets) or CABI might also be checked.</p> <p>As part of this project, Rebecca Lee proposed information exchange with OIRSA. A workshop with interactive discussions may be contemplated in the future to fine tune the information.</p>
