### Summary

Assignment 1:	Organize an international workshop on phytosanitary management of citrus pests and diseases, in collaboration with the Interamerican Coordinating Group in Plant Protection, to be held in Mexico.
Consensus:	Workshop will be in Colima State in August 2013. Details will be worked out by the Mexican members. Potential speakers were identified and a draft program was prepared. The list will be finalized and the invitees contacted.
Assignment 2:	Exchange information on the citrus quarantine pest situation in NAPPO member countries and strengthen links and the exchange of information on the situation of citrus quarantine pests with OIRSA and Caribbean countries.
Consensus:	Not discussed.
Assignment 3:	Revise and continuously update the annexes for RSPM 16, <i>Guidelines for the importation of citrus propagative material into a NAPPO member country</i> , and report on the implementation of this standard in NAPPO member countries.
Consensus:	The revised text was reviewed and modified by the participants, and approved it for submission to the Standards Panel.

Assignment 4:	Continue developing and finalize the document on recommended measures for the establishment and maintenance of area wide management programs for HLB and its vector.
Consensus:	The participants attended part of the <a href="#">Citrus Health Response Program Science and Technology Research Coordination Group</a> meeting dealing with area wide management. Several of the experts in attendance provided advice as to subject areas and potential contributors in these areas. Some experts agree to participate.
Assignment 5:	Review and adapt the diagnostic protocol for CTV according to ISPM 27, <i>Diagnostic protocols for regulated pests</i> .
Consensus:	Rebecca Lee has revised the format according to ISPM 27. It has to be reviewed briefly for any technical updates. The Panel approved the changes made.
