Assignment 1:	Develop RSPM 41, <i>Transfer of Oversight Programs</i> , based on the approved specifications.	
Consensus:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A draft standard was prepared describing the concept of oversight. It outlines criteria for establishment of oversight programs and for the different levels of involvement of the NPPOs and industry of the importing and exporting countries. Considerations are made for the review, duration and guidelines for reduction or termination of an oversight program. Criteria to be used when assessing the maturity of the program and its eligibility for reduction or termination, as well as the steps in such a process, are included. General information on the elements to be contained in workplans and costs associated with oversight programs are also provided. - This will be revised for editorial adjustments and translated by the NAPPO secretariat, and then sent to the Panel members for internal consultation. - Some of the elements of the specifications for this standard relate to the details that would be contained in a workplan, for which this standard provides guidelines.
