The topic area for this EG is cross sector as AGM is a pest that can affect several commodities and its pathways of introduction are largely conveyances and cargo (not commodity specific)

## **Progress Report 2018**

- Mexico's AGM program continued development and implementation
- Continued to implement recommendations from 2015 workshop
- Specified Risk Period Validation



## Mexico's AGM Program Development and Implementation

- As AGM poses a risk to both agriculture and forestry, SEMARNAT and SENASICA continue to work together to develop an AGM program in Mexico
- This includes work toward the establishment of a vessel certification program for AGM aligned with RSPM 33
- During the 2018 season, AGM egg masses were detected on a vessel that had all NAPPO countries on its itinerary
- Resulting communication showed how NAPPO countries could work together to reduce risk to any one of the three countries





## Validation of Specified Risk Periods for AGM in Regulated Countries of Origin

- Met with national plant protection organization representatives from the AGMregulated Asian countries to discuss data availability and sharing
- Received approval to share available data of AGM flight and population data among NAPPO countries
- Face-to-face AGM EG meeting in August 2018 to start review of shared data
- Workplan revised
  - Follow-up with regulated countries on some data points
  - Country-wise approach
  - Draft discussion document
  - Discuss outcomes of data review with regulated countries prior to NAPPO country consultation phase
  - NAPPO country consultation
  - Publish document
  - Implement any specified risk period changes



### **Proposed Activities for 2019 and Beyond**

- Continue to review and analyze data, prepare paper and make recommendations for Validation of Specified Risk Period
- Continued support for Mexico's development and implementation of an AGM program
- Continue to follow-up on recommendations from 2015
   workshop (e.g. hold workshop with the four regulated countries and
   regulating countries; develop on-line training and mobile apps)
